Resort Profile: Set amidst lush landscapes and Atlantic beachfront shores, Ponte Vedra Inn & Club has toted the reputation as the “grand dame” of North Florida resorts since 1928. The historic Inn & Club continues to receive the highest praise and most distinguished awards from the nation’s leading travel publications, including the prestigious AAA Five-Diamond, TripAdvisor’s Certificate of Excellence and Travel + Leisure’s World’s Best among others. The Inn & Club presents 250 elegantly appointed oversized guest rooms and suites, most overlooking the Atlantic Ocean. Ranging from gourmet to casual, the resort features nine restaurants, bars and lounges, including the signature Seahorse Grille with ocean views. The family-friendly resort also offers two picturesque 18-hole golf courses, 15 Har-Tru hydro tennis courts, three oceanfront pools, an 8,000 square foot oceanfront gym and a 30,000 square foot luxury spa. Comprising over 25,000 square feet of indoor meeting and exhibit space designed with comfort and elegance in mind, the Ponte Vedra Ballroom, Terrace Room and 17 meeting rooms cater to every meetings and incentives need. Guests staying at the Inn & Club also receive access to amenities and services to sister property Ponte Vedra Lodge & Club.

Location: Ponte Vedra Inn & Club is situated in North Florida, 22 miles southeast of Jacksonville and 26 miles north of historic St. Augustine. The resort is 31 miles (a 40-minute drive) from Jacksonville International Airport, which is served by all major airlines.

Climate: Semi-tropical climate that exhibits seasonal changes. Average daytime temperature for spring and summer months is 81 degrees Fahrenheit. Average daytime temperature for fall and winter months is 68 degrees Fahrenheit.

Restaurants & Lounges:

Seahorse Grille – The signature restaurant at Ponte Vedra Inn & Club, the Seahorse Grille offers dramatic ocean views from atop the Surf Club. The Seahorse Grille is an upscale but casual dining and cocktail experience. The Chef's culinary styles reflect boldly inspired flavors and an artfully imaginative menu. Favorite dishes include the Oven Roasted Pacific Halibut with Buckwheat Soba Noodles and Ginger Miso Broth; Vegetable Pasta with Sundried Tomato Pesto and Crispy Kale; and Surf n' Turf with Grilled Filet Mignon and Maine Lobster Tail. Open daily from 6-10pm and from 11am-2pm on Sunday's brunch.

Seafoam Dining Room (open seasonally) – Featuring a sophisticated menu of European and Continental culinary favorites, the Seafoam Dining Room sports oversized oceanfront windows revealing surf and beach below, a vaulted ceiling, cozy fireplace, oil paintings and rich, dark wood throughout. The Chef earns a gastronomic gold star for his artistic blending of textures and flavors. A distinguished wine list is also available. Jackets are required for gentlemen, ties encouraged. The Seafoam Dining Room seats 45 guests and is open for dinner Saturdays 6 – 10pm.

Inn Dining Room – Open for breakfast from 7 am – 10:30 am, the Inn Dining Room features a full breakfast buffet in addition to its a-la-cart menu.

Seahorse Grille Bar – Cocktails with a modern vibe, this lively oceanfront bar and lounge boasts a chic atmosphere, smart décor, and popular drink list. Live music is featured most evenings.

The Tavern – Adjacent to the main lobby, the recently renovated Tavern boasts a full bar, five HDTVs, a pool table and more. The 3,000 sq ft Tavern features new luxury fixtures and furnishings, accent artwork and dramatic lighting to complement an eclectic bar and small plates menu.

Golf Club Restaurant – Overlooking Ponte Vedra's lagoon and famous "Island 9th" golf hole, the Golf Club restaurant provides a casual and colorful atmosphere for lunch and dinner. The picturesque setting is complemented with an appetizing menu of soups, salads and specialty sandwiches for lunch. The popular and diverse dinner menu features a wonderful selection of steaks, local seafood and daily specials. Open daily from 11:30 am – 3 pm, and 5:30 pm – 9 pm for dinner on Fridays and Saturdays.

Surf Club Patio – The Surf Club Patio features seaside lunch options in a casual, oceanfront setting below a colorful canopy of umbrellas. The Surf Club Patio serves a wide selection of soups, sandwiches and salads from 11:30 am – 3 pm, March through October (weather permitting).

High Tides Bar – Open daily from 10 am to dusk, this oceanfront “barefoot and bikini” bar specializes in sandwiches, light snacks, a hot dog menu and frozen specialty drinks.

The Gourmet Shop – Located in the lobby, the Gourmet Shop is a charming cafe environment sporting casual bistro tables, chairs and ornate ceiling fans. Open daily from 6 am – 7 pm, the Gourmet Shop serves Starbucks coffee, freshly baked muffins, tarts, ice cream, a selection of wines and gourmet gifts.

Sports / Recreational Activities:

Beach – Stretching miles down the Atlantic Coast, Ponte Vedra’s palm fringed beach provides the ideal setting for a sunrise jog, shell hunting, a picnic lunch or tanning. Beachside rentals include: umbrellas, beach chairs, surfboards, kayaks and bicycles.

Golf – The Ponte Vedra Inn & Club features two 18-hole golf courses; three putting greens, pitching/chipping greens, a practice bunker, complete pro shop, a teaching staff of six, private lessons, lockers and showers, club repair and cleaning, nightly bag storage, new carts, professional shoe shine, 19th hole lounge and various golf packages. Designed in 1928 by famed British architect Herbert Bertram Strong, the **Ocean Course** is a par-72, 6,811-yard course, with 99 strategically positioned sand bunkers. A par-70 course, the 6,022-yard **Lagoon Course** was co-authored by two design geniuses – Robert Trent Jones with the front nine holes in 1961, and Joe Lee with the back nine holes in 1977. In 2007, Bobby Weed fully restored the layout, including new tees, fairways and greens, routing changes on several holes, new turf standards, improved irrigation and drainage, and a greatly enhanced landscape theme. Water is a dominant feature on 11 holes.

Tennis – The tennis program at the Ponte Vedra Inn & Club has been rated as “one of the top adult tennis camps in the nation” by Tennis magazine, and holds the honored status as the “Official Tennis Club of the ATP World Tour.” Cradled between green fairways and the Atlantic Ocean, the resort features 15 Har-Tru clay courts, private teaching courts, eight courts lit for night play, shaded courtside pavilions, a clubhouse, computerized ball machines, Pro Shop with tennis accessories and equipment, locker rooms, courtside patio, oversized practice backboard, and various tennis packages.

Pools - Three oceanfront heated pools are available: a family pool with water slide and neighboring playground, an adults-only lap pool, and a children’s wading pool. Lifeguards are on duty year round. Swimming lessons available.

Children’s Activities – Throughout the year, the Recreation Department conducts numerous children’s activities, such as pizza parties, movies, playground activities, storytelling, arts and crafts, etiquette class and organized games. A comprehensive summer youth camp is available from June through August for kids 4-12 years old. Counselors direct organized games, swimming instruction, beach walks, tennis, golf and arts and crafts.

Children’s Nursery – Open year-round, the children’s nursery is open from 8 am- 7 pm M-F, 8 am-4 pm Saturdays, and 8 am – noon on Sundays for children ages 6 months – 13 years old.

Nearby Recreation – Additional recreational activities located near the resort include deep sea fishing charters, horseback riding, a family theme park, and historic downtown St. Augustine.

Fitness Center:

The only oceanfront gym in northeast Florida, the second floor gym facility at the Inn & Club boasts over 8,000 square feet of space. The three-tier gym offers dramatic views of the beach and Atlantic Ocean, which features various equipment for cardiovascular exercise and strength training with Cybex resistance equipment and free weights. The gym also hosts multiple TV's, and three exercise studios for cycling, aerobics and pilates. Over eighty exercise classes are available per week and are available to resort guests complimentary, including indoor cycling, step aerobics, circuit training, strength training, cardio circuit, aquacize, yoga, barre and core training and more.

The Spa:

The region's largest spa, the 30,000 sq. ft. spa at the Inn & Club combines peaceful surroundings and ultra-modern facilities with an impressive selection of more than a hundred beauty and pampering services. The Spa has an exclusive partnership with Zents, allowing for guests to customize their experience by combining specialized scents with their treatment. The in-house Spa Café serves a health-conscious menu, located in the elegant marble gathering room of the spa. A highlight of the Spa is its Hydrotherapy pool, which boasts five relaxing grottos, including standing bubbler, chaise lounge bubbler, Jacuzzi, swimmers treadmill and waterfall.

The full-service **Salon** at the Ponte Vedra Spa provides guests with dozens of salon services, including men and women's haircuts, styling and coloring services, keratin treatments, manicures, pedicures, masques and more.
